ALUM CREEK DEPUTY REGISTRAR TO CLOSE

COLUMBUS – The Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Deputy Registrar Agency located at 1583 Alum Creek Drive in Columbus will close at the end of business on Feb. 28, 2009.

Deputy Registrars offer driver license, identification card (ID), and vehicle registration services. While most Deputy Registrar agencies are operated by separate contractors for the state, the Deputy Registrar agencies at 1583 Alum Creek Drive and at 1970 West Broad Street are both state-run agencies. All of the employees currently working at the Alum Creek Deputy Registrar agency will be assimilated into vacant positions at the West Broad Street agency and within the BMV central office.

This consolidation of services will improve operating efficiencies within the BMV while maintaining driver licensing and reinstatement services in the Franklin County area. In addition to the 1970 West Broad Street agency, there are 15 other Deputy Registrar agencies in Franklin County; seven are within six miles of the Alum Creek location. The Reinstatement Center located at Alum Creek will remain open to the public but the driver examination, road and written, testing services currently located at the Alum Creek Facility will also move with the consolidation of services.

In addition to these changes, the hours of operation for the Deputy Registrar at 1970 West Broad Street will change beginning the week of March 2, 2009. New hours for the locations will be as follows:

- Closed Mondays
- 8:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. - Tuesday through Friday
- 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. - Saturday
