LIMA DEPUTY REGISTRAR MOVING TO NEW LOCATION

COLUMBUS – The Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Deputy Registrar agency located at 2010 Spencerville Rd., Lima will be closing early (noon instead of 2 p.m.) and moving on Saturday, Nov. 28, 2009. The agency will re-open at its new location, 419 N. Elizabeth St., Lima, on Tuesday, Dec. 1, 2009.

The new location will offer one-stop shopping services with the Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP) driver license examination station, deputy registrar license agency, and Clerk of Courts title office, along with a unique “drive through” option for customers completing vehicle registration transactions.

The hours of operation will remain the same:

- 8:00 a.m. - 6:30 p.m. Monday
- 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. T-W-TH-F
- 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. Saturday
