COLUMBUS – The majority of Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicle Deputy Registrar locations across the state will be closed or offering limited services on Monday, Jan. 21, 2013, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

In particular, the Deputy Registrar/Driver Examination/Title Office located at 301 Huron St., Jackson, OH 45640 will be closed Monday, January 21 **and** Tuesday, January 22, 2013 for remodeling. They will reopen at 8 a.m. on Wednesday, January 23, 2013.
