Gov. John R. Kasich established the Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory board to oversee implementation of recommendations from the Ohio Task Force on Community-Police Relations.

The new standards include:

- Use of Force;
- Use of Deadly Force; and
- Agency Employee Recruitment and Hiring.
