**OIU: Eight Cleveland residents indicted on food stamp fraud case**

**(Columbus)** - - On Sept. 21, eight Cleveland residents were indicted by the Cuyahoga Grand Jury in a food stamp case based on charges filed by agents with the Ohio Investigative Unit.

Agents began investigating food stamp fraud activity at Cee Jays Deli, 12914 Griffing Avenue in Cleveland. As a result of the investigation, Carol Fahie, 58, and Jason Daily, 34, were each indicted on one count of trafficking in or illegal use of food stamps, telecommunications fraud, grand theft, drug possession and trafficking offense. Eddie Poe, 40; Desmen Ramsey, 50; Darryl Ramsey, 48; Ceirra Carter, 26; Harold Eathridge, 23; and Karaenus Nelson, 29, were each indicted on one count of trafficking in or illegal use of food stamps.
