## **OHIO COLLABORATIVE COMMUNITY-POLICE ADVISORY BOARD TO MEET DECEMBER 1**

**COLUMBUS** – The Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory Board will meet this week at the Ohio Department of Public Safety, at which time board members will receive an update on law enforcement agency certifications and discuss pending standards from the previous meeting.

There will also be a presentation by the Honorable Stephen L. McIntosh from the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas regarding the Supreme Court of Ohio's Task Force report on recommendations for improvements to the Ohio Grand Jury System.

Gov. John R. Kasich established the Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory board to oversee implementation of recommendations from the Ohio Task Force on Community-Police Relations.

The community-law enforcement advisory panel developed – for the first time in Ohio history – state standards on use of force, including deadly force, and agency recruitment and hiring, that can help guide Ohio law enforcement agencies on Aug. 28, 2015.
