### **Akron man charged in an illegal sales case**

(CANTON) – Agents with the Ohio Investigative Unit and officers with the Akron Police Department conducted a search warrant at an Akron business for illegal sales on February 18.

The search warrant was conducted at Jobeata Enterprises, LLC., also known as the Wood, 752 East Archwood Avenue. Agents charged Nathan Hendon, 56, of Akron with four counts of illegal sale of beer or intoxicating liquor without a permit.

During the search warrant, agents seized 636 bottles of liquor and beer, as well as \$700 in U.S. currency.

Hendon is scheduled to appear in Akron Municipal Court on March 3.
