Re: Administrative rules regarding the Transportation of Pupils

Dear Stakeholder,

You are invited to offer public comment regarding the proposed filing of Chapter 4501-1 (Transportation of Pupils) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) as outlined in this notice. This filing is in response to a scheduled five-year rule review pursuant to section 119.032 of the Revised Code.

You are receiving this message pursuant to the requirements of Executive Order 2011-011K and Senate Bill 2 of the 129th General Assembly, which require state agencies, including the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of State Highway Patrol (OSP), to draft rules in collaboration with stakeholders, assess and justify any adverse impact on the business community (as defined by Senate Bill 2), and provide opportunity for interested parties to provide input on proposed rules.

OSP recommends that Chapter 4501-1 be filed without change with the exception of rules 4501-1-05 and 4501-1-08, which are proposed for amendment to update Administrative Code rule references from 3301-20-01 to 3301-83-23.

All interested parties are invited to offer public comment at OSP.rules@dps.state.oh.us regarding the proposed changes. Public comments may be submitted through 11:59 p.m. on Sunday, October 28, 2012.
