

The development of the OIBRS Portal for online access to OIBRS crime statistics and crime mapping provides options for advanced queries, reports, and data analysis at the fingertips of law enforcement agencies. Along with processing monthly crime data from Ohio law enforcement, OCJS provides training and assists agencies with automating their records and reporting processes. Assistance is also provided to records management system software vendors who are seeking to obtain OIBRS certification, which will allow their clients to participate in the OIBRS program.
