What Is the Law Enforcement Officer's Toolkit?

- The Law Enforcement Officer's Toolkit (LEOT), developed by the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS), is a software solution for Ohio law enforcement agencies in need of a records management system.
- More than 390 local law enforcement agencies use the LEOT to manage information on calls for service, offense reports, citations, crash reports, investigations, field interviews, warrants, jail management, property room management and investigator notes. Of the total agencies, 45 cover a population of over 10,000. There are more than 25 sheriffs' offices using the toolkit software. The LEOT also provides a master name index and other search capabilities.
- The software is easily accessed on laptops in the field and enables police departments and sheriffs' offices to participate in: the Ohio Incident-Based Reporting System (OIBRS) program for state and FBI electronic crime reporting, the Electronic Crash Submission (ECS) for electronic traffic crash reporting, and the Ohio Local Law Enforcement Information Sharing Network (OLLEISN) for electronic information-sharing among participating law enforcement agencies.

What Is the Cost for Agencies to Use the LEOT?

- The LEOT was created with federal grant funding, so OCJS is able to provide the high-quality software package free to law enforcement agencies. A minimal, annual flat fee of \$350

provides agencies with LEOT maintenance, support, training and updates. This represents a substantial cost savings to law enforcement agencies in place of using other more expensive software for records management needs.

What Are the System Requirements Needed to Run the LEOT?

- The LEOT works with Access 97, 2000, XP, and SQL Server databases.
- The LEOT works with Windows 2000, Professional, XP and Vista client operating systems. Servers that are NT 4.0, 2000 Server, 2003 Server, and Novell work with the software.

What Software Support is Provided?

- LEOT has extended its hours of support outside of normal business hours. On the current schedule, Level I support is provided from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. Monday thru Friday, and 7 a.m. - 2 p.m. on Saturday.
- Most support issues are successfully addressed remotely. Only in rare situations may a site visit be required.

What are Some of the Enhanced Features of the LEOT?

- **Mobile LEADS.**
The current build of the LEOT has a module for mobile LEADS. This allows officers instant access to the information they need to do a criminal history check in the field. It alerts them on wanted persons and stolen vehicles, thereby increasing officer safety. Because the

officers can do a LEADS check themselves, the need to radio every request to the station is reduced, thereby freeing up the 911 dispatcher. In addition, the LEADS module is tightly integrated with the rest of the LEOT, thereby making it easy to transfer information from the LEADS results into specific modules.

- **Bureau of Motor Vehicle (BMV) Interface.**
The LEOT also has an interface with the BMV that allows officers to access driving history, personal license information and vehicle registration information in the field.
- **Automated Information Upload.**
The LEOT allows for automated uploads of OIBRS data, traffic crash data, and OLLEISN information-sharing data. This frees up officer time to continue serving out in the community.
- **Enhanced Help Desk.**
OCJS has an enhanced help desk for LEOT users. LEOT customers can request support over an Internet chat window. Using this form of support, LEOT staff can repair most problems in full view of the customer.
- **OLLEISN Level II Certified.**
The LEOT is OLLEISN Level II certified. A rich user interface in the LEOT allows officers to search OLLEISN records.
