

Local Enforcement Results: STEP

Federal funds, administered by the Governor's Highway Safety Office (GHSO), continue to support overtime enforcement initiatives for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) to attack crash problems utilizing a blitz format and overtime enforcement.

Local jurisdictions were identified in counties that represented a significant traffic-related fatality and/or serious injury problem. Within the 27 targeted counties, each sheriff's department and local law enforcement agency received invitations to participate in STEP in FFY 2002.

Objectives of the blitzes and overtime enforcement:

- Increase the public perception of increased enforcement;
- Increase the number of arrests for speed, impaired driving, and non-use of occupant restraint devices;
- Attract publicity for local programs; and
- Change behaviors related to traffic safety problems.

The "blitz" format included a media announcement, increased enforcement on selected locations, and data. The selection of specific sites and time of enforcement activity was left to each local agency but was based in part on the available crash data. Local media attention was a significant part of the overall program success. Through enhanced media coverage, a much broader public information message was possible.

FFY 2002 crash data are not currently available to evaluate the impact of this program. Yet, FFY 2002 activity reports indicate some more immediate results. The chart compares composite numbers from local agency activity reports from FFY 1998 - 2002.
