Why Pay the Price?

Geared for men 21 to 34, the Governor's Highway Safety Office (GHSO) of the Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS) recently kicked off the "Ask Jason" campaign to try to curb drinking and driving among this age group. According to statistics, this age group seems fearless. They don't believe it will happen to them—except it does.

In Ohio in 2001, there were 4,274 drinking drivers in all crashes in the 26-35 age group. In fatal crashes, there were 106 drinking drivers out of 374, or 28.3 percent, which is the highest of any age group.

Who is Jason? Jason is a guy that represents many guys. They enjoy life...they party and then drive home. But they never think that a serious crash will happen to them, until it does.

Sometimes they face the fact that they will never walk again. They seem to worry about the high financial costs and the deep embarrassment of doing jail time. But if they have killed or injured someone, they will suffer life-long guilt. Their life will never be the same.

The emphasis on the campaign mentions the legal and financial consequences that come from drinking and driving. It is a choice that people can control.

The brochure for the campaign, "Why Pay the Price? Don't Drink and Drive" shows a car wrapped around a tree and a guy in a wheelchair on the cover. It spells out what happens when a person is convicted of the first offense of driving under the influence (DUI) and the consequences of additional offenses.

The campaign urges people, young men in particular, to make an investment in their future by not drinking and driving. Drivers are urged to think twice if they or their friends are tempted to drive after drinking. Says the literature, "You know the price. Why even risk paying it?"
