

Drunk Driver Kills State Trooper

It happened again. Another drunk driver, who was also a repeat offender, struck and killed a state trooper on November 5, 2001.

Tpr. Frank G. Vazquez, 26, of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's West Jefferson post, succumbed to injuries on Nov. 6 that he sustained in a Nov. 5 evening traffic crash in Columbus.

Tpr. Vazquez joined the Patrol in February 1997 as a member of the 128th Academy Class and received his commission on July 25, 1997. He served at the Defiance post prior to transferring to West Jefferson on December 3, 2000. Originally from Defiance, Tpr. Vazquez graduated from Defiance High School in 1993, and later studied at Toledo University and The Ohio State University. Tpr. Vazquez lived in Marysville with his wife Kristina, and their three children: Christian, 5, Kyra, 3, and Noah, 1.

"Tpr. Vazquez distinguished himself as a leader in the Highway Patrol. His passing is a great loss to the Patrol family and our sympathies are with his family and friends," Col. Kenneth L. Morckel, Ohio State Highway Patrol superintendent said.

The Patrol said preliminary reports indicate Tpr. Vazquez stopped a vehicle to issue a traffic violation. During the stop, a northbound vehicle struck Tpr. Vazquez's cruiser from behind, sending it into the stopped vehicle. Tpr. Vazquez was outside his cruiser when he was struck. The person who struck Vazquez, David Dye, 33, of Westerville, had a 0.318 blood alcohol level (BAC)

when he was involved in the crash that killed Tpr. Frank Vazquez, according to an OSHP toxicology report.

The funeral was held November 10, 2001, in Marysville. The Vazquez Children's Fund has been established at Bank One to support the three children of Tpr. Frank Vazquez. Donations can be made at any Bank One location in Ohio.
