

Partnership For Reducing Fatalities

In the first few months of 2004, Perry County law enforcement officials were faced with an alarming increase in the rate of fatality and serious injury accidents on state and rural county roadways within the county. Perry County, which has a small residential population, experienced ten accidents resulting in 12 fatalities in the first six months of the year, prompting officials to examine causes for the increase and work toward solutions to stop the rate of fatalities.

OSHP Lt. Gary Lewis of the Lancaster Post did a problem analysis and developed a plan for a high visibility/zero tolerance enforcement program known as the "Fatal Free Reduction" program. The "Fatal Free Reduction Program" plan involves Troopers from Lancaster OSHP partnering with Deputies from the Perry County Sheriff's Office to share enforcement responsibilities on those roads that experienced fatalities within the county.

With emphasis on OVI detection and apprehension, law enforcement in Perry County has also been focusing on aggressive driving violations and the failure to wear seat belts, which has been a common thread in most of the accidents this year.

A second prevention component is a localized media campaign by law enforcement that shares the common messages about driving impaired and the need to wear safety belts. In several locations throughout the county, billboards with a joint message from Lieutenant Lewis and Perry County Sheriff William Barker are displayed. The billboards have been placed along roadways that experienced fatalities or serious injury collisions in the hopes that the message will promote safe driving practices.

According to Lt. Lewis, since the inception of the "Fatal Free Deduction Program," there have been no fatalities in Perry County. Troopers and Deputies plan to continue the aggressive patrols throughout the remainder of 2004 and continue the program in 2005 with specific focus upon safety belt usage, impaired driving prevention, and other serious traffic violations that contribute to fatalities.
