

# ADA Notice

## ADA Information

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) shall make available to applicants, participants, beneficiaries, and other interested persons information regarding the provisions of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and its applicability to the services, programs, or activities of DPS, and make such information available to them in such manner as the Director of DPS finds necessary to apprise such persons of the protections against discrimination assured them by the ADA.

DPS shall ensure that interested people, including people with vision or hearing impairments, can obtain information as to the existence and location of accessible services, activities, and facilities.

## ADA Grievance Process

DPS has a grievance procedure which provides people who believe they have been discriminated against because of their disability, or others who believe they have been discriminated against because they have a friend or family member with a disability, with a formal process to make their complaint known.
